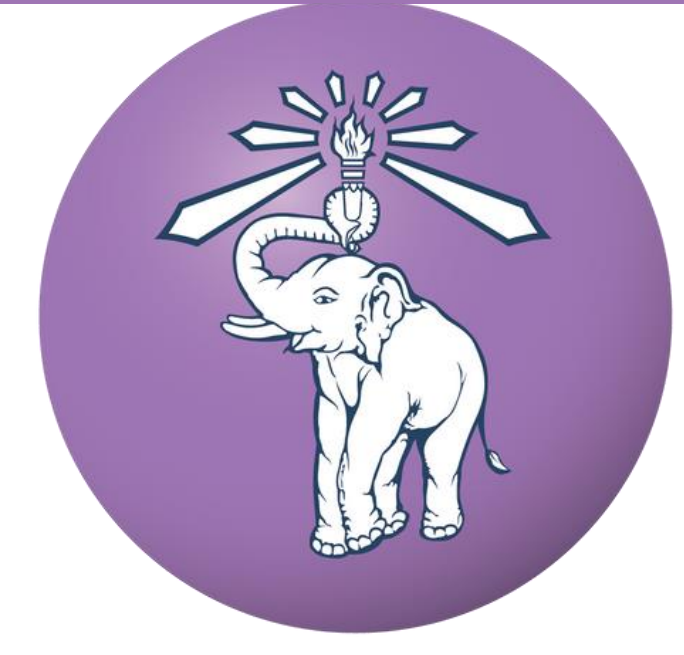

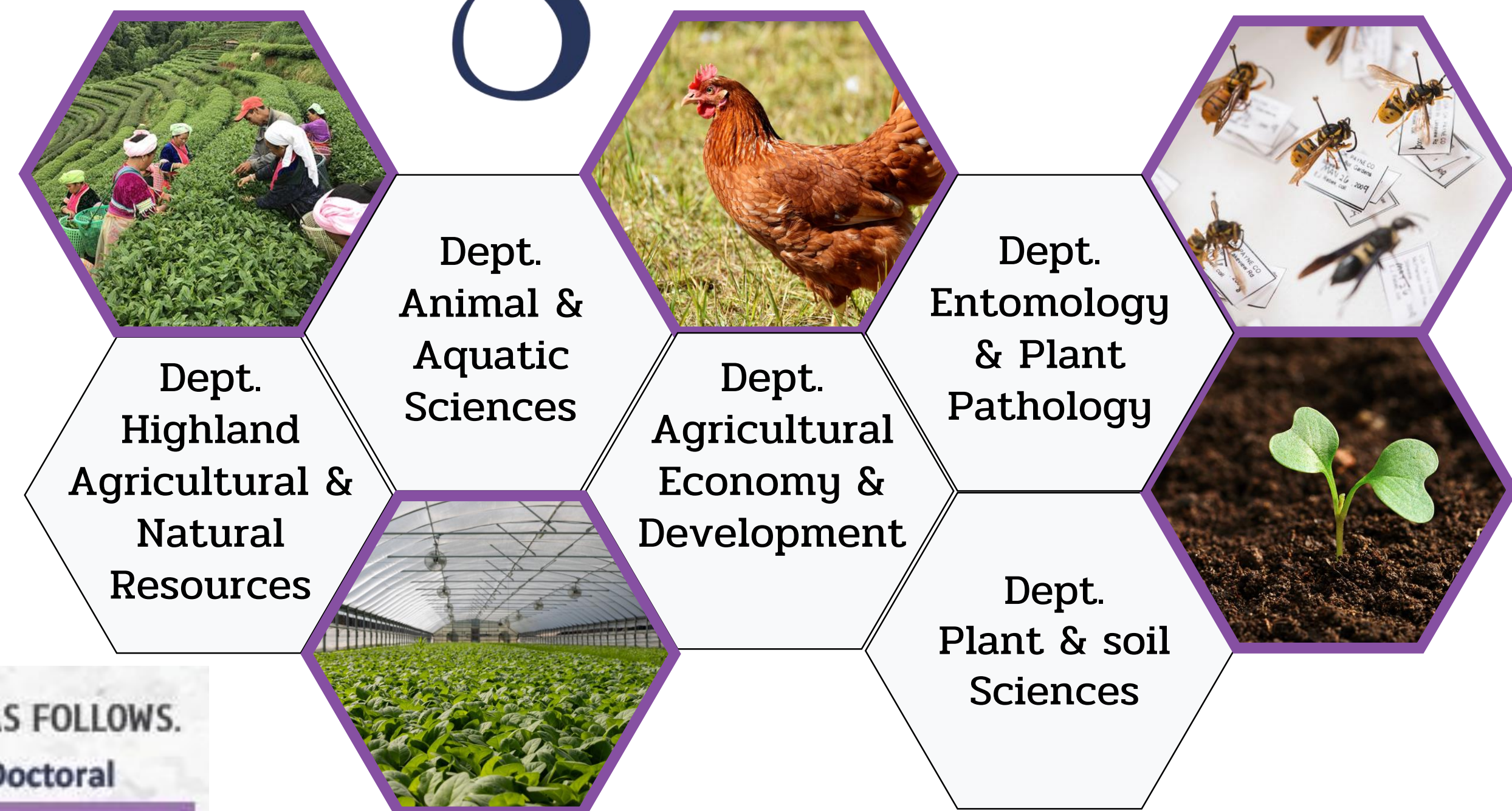

5. Agriculture and Forestry Climate Change Research Center (AFCC)

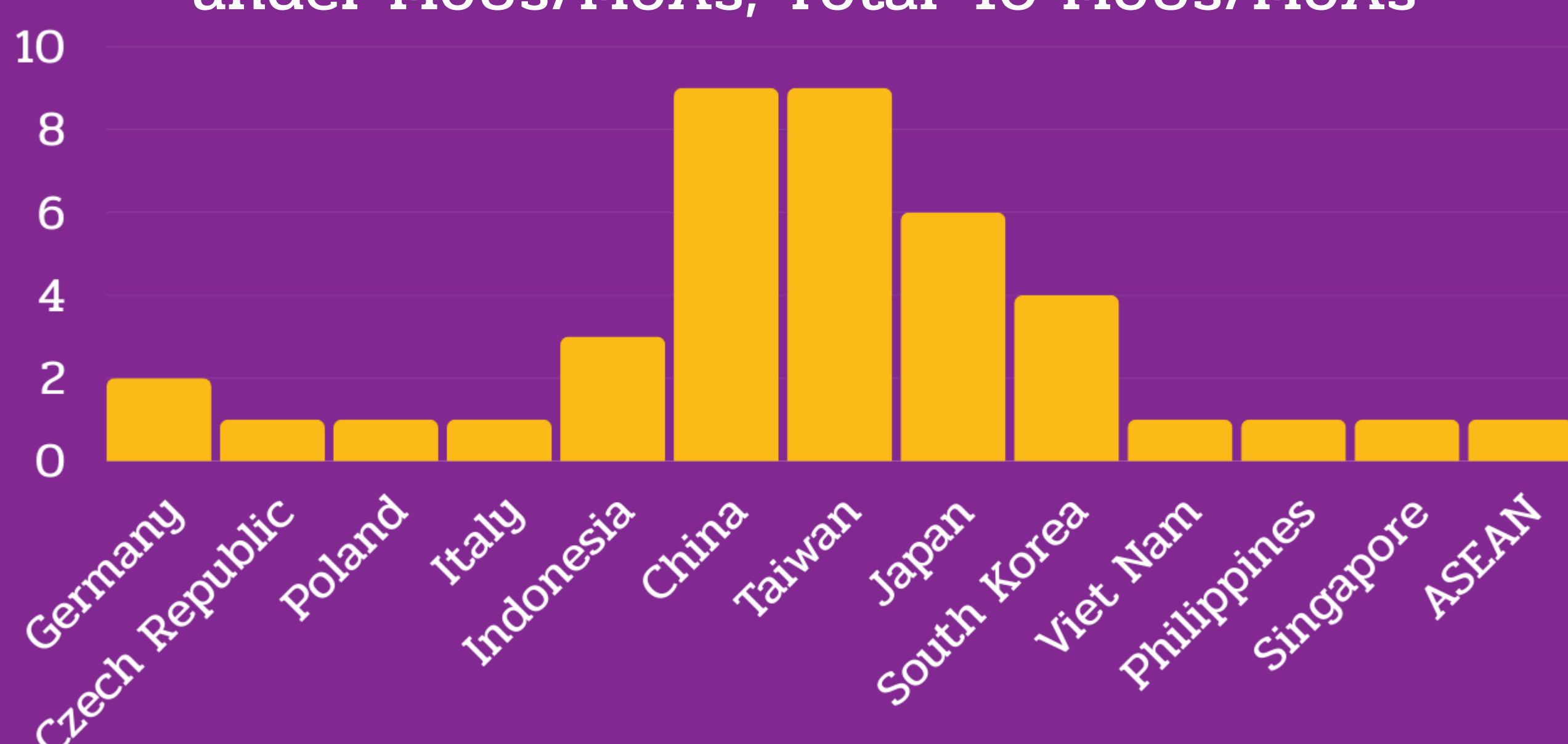
INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION NETWORK:
